Lessons from the coronavirus: distance learning organizations

Universal distance learning is one of the innovations that the Coronavirus Pandemic has brought to our lives. Schools and universities had to urgently convert their programs into online format, and it turned out that many of them were not ready for it.

Set of calls

The school treated this situation as a set of calls. Will we be able to master new technologies as quickly as possible in a rapidly changing world? Will we be able not to lose the pace and not to bring down the rhythm of education of schoolchildren? Will we be able to broadcast our position as clearly as possible to parents and children? Preparation

Feedback showed that online lessons take much more effort than regular lessons. It turned out to be very difficult for many people to withstand four meetings with classmates and teachers in a row. In this regard, the online format requires longer breaks than the normal form of learning.

Disadvantages of distance learning for students

It turned out that children have difficulties working with large formats (essays, term papers). But nowadays there are services that can gladly provide writing <u>cheap term papers</u> and students often take advantage of this advantage.

Problems and successes

Obviously, there are technical problems - it hangs, doesn't load and doesn't display correctly. That the children didn't have time to pick up their textbooks from the school, and not everyone has a circus, a laptop or the necessary books in the places where they are. That it takes much longer to get ready for online lessons than usual.

And most importantly, it is terrible to imagine with what joy we all rush to embrace, when we see each other in reality!
